Q: When I need to draw a line to separate schedules, I insert a horizontal graphics line by pressing Graphics (Alt-F9), (5) Line, (1) Horizontal and Exit (F7). Is there a way to draw a double line without going into Font (Ctrl-F8), (2) Appearance, (3) Dbl Und and spacing across the page? – Christine C. Reynolds, West Conshohocken, PA

A: Use the included DOUBLEU.WPM macro. To use the macro, place the cursor **at the end** of the line that you want the double line to appear. Press Macro (Alt-F10), type "doubleu" and press (Enter). To see how the lines will print, press Print (Shift-F7), (6) View Document. Press Exit (F7) when finished.
