

Capitalize a Phrase

The included INITCAP.WPM macro upper-cases the first letter and lower-cases the remaining letters of each word of a phrase (such as a title or heading) that has already been typed. For example, "NOW IS THE TIME!" will become "Now Is The Time!"

To use the macro, move the cursor to the first character of the first word in the phrase, press (Alt-F10), type "initcap" and press (Enter). At the prompt, type the number of words in the phrase and press (Enter).
