

Cool New Borders  
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The included TBBORDER.WPM macro places a single graphic repeated along the top and bottom of any paper size you have selected. (The "TB" in the macro name stands for "Top Bottom.")

To use the macro, go to a clear document screen. Select any paper size you want. Then press Macro (Alt-F10) and type *tbborder*. The macro takes you into your default graphics directory. You can highlight other directories and press (Enter) to change to them, or highlight a graphic file and press (Enter) to use it in the border. The macro creates a top and bottom border for your page (see figure below using a balloons graphic) and leaves you in View Document. Press Exit (F7) to return to your document screen. Type the information you want between the borders, then print and/or save your document.

The macro uses Header B and Footer B, so if you use headers and footers in the document, be sure to use Header A and Footer A.
