

Copy Macros From One Keyboard to Another

Q&A

Q: I have several keyboards, all containing macros I use frequently. I want to put all of my macros onto one keyboard so I won't have to switch keyboards all the time. How can I do this? – Tedi Weber, Olympia, WA

A: The included KEYCOPY.WPM macro will copy your macros from one keyboard to another. To use the macro, press Macro (Alt-F10), type "keycopy" and press (Enter). Highlight the keyboard you're copying from and press (Enter). Highlight the macro you're copying and press (Enter) again. *(Note: You can copy only one macro at a time.)*

At the Setup: Keyboard Layout screen, highlight the keyboard you're copying to and press (Enter). You'll be asked what key you want to assign the macro to. Press any key, Ctrl+letter or Alt+letter combination that doesn't already exist. The macro is then assigned to the key you've chosen. When you've finished copying one macro, you'll be asked if you want to copy another. If you answer (Y) Yes, you'll be allowed to copy another macro. If you answer (N) No, the macro quits.
