

Create Alternating Graphic Page Borders
WordPerfect Magazine
Bonus Macro

The included ALTERNAT.WPM macro creates an alternating graphic border on the top and bottom of any paper size.

In this case, "alternating" refers to the graphic(s) you choose. If you choose only one graphic, no alternating will be necessary, but the top and bottom borders will still be created. However, if you choose two or more graphics, those graphics will alternate on both the top and bottom borders.

See the figure below for a sample top border of balloons and ducks.

To use the macro, press Macro (Alt-F10), type *alternat* and press (Enter). You'll be taken to your graphics default directory and the prompt, Highlight graphic file, press (Enter) appears at the bottom of the screen. You can highlight a graphic file and press (Enter) to accept, or you can highlight a directory and press (Enter) to change directories.

After you've selected the first graphic, the prompt Choose another graphic? (Y/N) appears. If you press (Y) Yes, you're asked to highlight a graphic file again. You may add as many graphics as you'd like. If you press (N) No, the macro creates the border and takes you to Print (Shift-F7), (6) View Document to view the border. Press Exit (F7) when finished viewing.

Caveat: The macro automatically replaces Headers A and B and Footers A and B.
