

Create Checkboxes with Macros

I frequently need a checkbox in a document. Because of this, I created the included macros: CHBOX.WPM, which creates a checkbox without an X; and CHBOXX.WPM, which creates a checkbox with an X (see figures below).

To use these macros, place your cursor in the desired position, then press Macro (Alt-F10), type the name of the desired macro, and press (Enter).
