

Create a Watermark with a Macro  
WordPerfect Magazine  
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The included WATERMRK.WPM macro will create either a graphic or text watermark in three different shades.

To use the macro, press Macro (Alt-F10), type *watermrk* and press (Enter). At the first prompt, choose (1) Graphic for a graphic watermark or (2) Text for a text watermark.

- At the Store Watermark in Header A; Header B: prompt, make sure you choose a header that is not currently in use, or it will be replaced with the watermark. Choose either (A) Header A or (B) Header B for the appropriate header.
- At the Watermark contrast: Light; Medium; Heavy: M prompt, choose (L) Light if you want a very light watermark. Press (M) Medium or (Enter) if you want a medium watermark. Press (H) Heavy if you want a dark watermark.
- At the Highlight a scalable font, press (Enter) prompt, use the (Up Arrow) and (Down Arrow) to highlight the font and press (Enter) to select. If you selected a scalable font, the prompt Point size: will appear. Type the desired point size, at least a 60-point font, and press (Enter). If you decided to type text for the watermark, type your message at the Enter watermark text: prompt and press (Enter).

If you decided to use a graphic image for the watermark, you're taken to your graphics directory. The prompt, Highlight graphic for Watermark, press (Enter) appears. Use the (Up Arrow) and (Down Arrow) keys to highlight the desired graphic and press (Enter). Each graphic will vary in its contrast depending on the color and quality of the original graphic.

The watermark will quickly be created and placed in the header you chose, a bell will sound and Watermark Created! will flash on your screen briefly.

*Note: You will only be able to view graphic watermarks in View Document – (Shift-F7), 6.*
