Q: I often find it hard to remember what screen colors I've set for many of my attributes. I usually end up going into the Setup: Colors menu to refresh my memory. Is there an easier way? – Kimberly McKeon, Canyon Country, CA

A: The included SCRCOLOR.WPM macro can help you out. It creates a prompt that displays all 20 attributes on the right side of your screen (see figure below). As soon as you press any key, the prompt disappears. This macro allows you to compare the attributes in your document with the actual settings.

Now, when you want to see your screen colors of the different attributes, at your document screen press Macro (Alt-F10), type "scrcolor" and press (Enter). The screen colors are displayed on the screen. Press any key to remove the prompt.
