

Easy Parentheses

Tips

I've created the included PAR.WPM macro that places parentheses on either side of a section of blocked text.

To place parentheses around your text, press Block (Alt+F4), block the desired text and press an open parenthesis. When you press an open parenthesis by itself, you'll only get an open parenthesis.

You can also replace the parentheses in the macro with anything you like, such as smart quotes, brackets and international punctuation pairs like ¿? or ¡!. Just change lines 4 and 5.

Note: For ease of use, you may want to assign the macro to a keyboard or to rename it with an Alt-letter combination.
