I teach computing for the local community education program, and often prepare handouts that list commands, screen displays and action keys.

When I give instructions that include pressing (Enter), aka "Return," I like to illustrate this command with an arrow (↵). I created the included ARROW.WPM macro to automatically insert the character into my documents.

Now when you need the Enter or Return arrow, place your cursor where you want it to appear, press Macro (Alt-F10), type "arrow" and press (Enter).
