

Macros to Repeat Searches

The included pair of macros for WP 5.1, SL.WPM and SR.WPM, are handy for searching up (back) and down (forward) through text or in the Look screen.

SL.WPM will search up/back from the current cursor location, and SR.WPM will search down/forward from the current cursor location.

The macros are convenient if renamed as (Alt-<) and (Alt->), but other Alt keys can be used.

The search string is remembered until you change it or close WP, even if you press F2 to search for a different string. The string can include *some* codes, such as Enter or Tab, but for other codes, use F2.

A location marker shows briefly when the macro finds a string. Its duration can be adjusted by editing the macros and changing the number on the last line.

Ways to Set or Change the String

If the string is on the screen, press (Alt-F4) to block it, then play one of the macros.

or

To change the existing string, press (Alt-F4), then, without moving the cursor (which would create a new block), play one of the macros and it will ask for a new string.

or

If no string has yet been set and blocking is off, play one of the macros and it will ask for a string to be entered.
