Q: I need to blank my document screen with one keystroke. This is necessary when I'm writing confidential material in a public setting. Is there any way to do this? – Ron Terpening, Tucson, AZ

A: The included macro, BLANK.WPM, will do what you're asking. You will want to rename the macro to an Alt-letter combination to fulfill your one-keystroke requirement. Then just press that combination, and your screen goes blank until you press (Enter). Your document is then returned exactly as you left it.
