

Advise of the Completion of a Print Job

Using a system variable, you can create a simple macro to have WordPerfect notify you when it has finished sending a print job. This is especially useful if you have a large print job that will take several minutes to print and you need to know as soon as it's finished.

The macro is included as PRNTBEEP.WPM.

To run the macro, first print the document as you normally would, using Print (Shift-F7). After you send the print job, press Macro (Alt-F10), type "prntbeep" and press (Enter). The macro waits until the print job has finished, then beeps.

Note: If the file is small, WordPerfect may finish printing the file before you have a chance to run the macro. In this case the bell sounds as soon as you run the macro.
