

Create Alternating Graphic Page Borders
WordPerfect Magazine
Bonus Macro

The included ALTERNAT.WPM macro creates an alternating graphic border on the top and bottom of any paper size.

In this case, "alternating" refers to the graphic(s) you choose. If you choose only one graphic, no alternating will be necessary, but the top and bottom borders will still be created. However, if you choose two or more graphics, those graphics will alternate on both the top and bottom borders.

To use the macro, press Play Macro (Alt+F10), type *alternat* and press (Enter). At the first prompt, How many graphics do you want to use?, type a number and press (Enter). At the Alternate Graphic Border dialog box (see Figure 1 below), the instructions appear prescribing how to select the graphic images you want in the border. Select each of the Graphic X: prompts, press List (F5) twice, highlight the graphic image you want and press (Enter). Press (Enter) again when finished selecting all the images. When the macro is finished, you'll see the page in Print Preview. Press Exit (F7) when finished viewing.

Caveat: The macro automatically replaces Headers A and B and Footers A and B.


