

Make Text Stand Out with Redline

Tips

The included REDLINE.WPM macro allows you to mark text you want to stand out by turning it red.

To play the macro *before* you type your text, press Macro (Alt-F10), type *redline* and press (Enter). Type your text, then press (Right Arrow) when you're done to turn the Redline attribute off.

To play the macro *after* you've typed your text, block the text by pressing Block (Alt-F4) and highlighting the text you want redlined. Then press Macro (Alt-F10), type *redline* and press (Enter).
