

Move Between Sentences

When I edit my work, I like to move sentence by sentence. I've devised two included macros that help me edit quickly.

The first, called SENTPREV.WPM, moves the cursor to the beginning of the current sentence or to the beginning of the previous sentence, if you're already at the beginning of a sentence.

The second macro is called SENTNEXT.WPM. This macro moves the cursor to the beginning of the next sentence. If it encounters the end of a paragraph, the cursor comes to rest on the hard return code.

To make these macros easier to use, rename them as Alt+letter macros or assign them to a Button Bar.
